Description	Carpenters construct, erect, install, finish and repair wooden structures and fixtures on residential and commercial buildings. This is the entry point for Apprentice Carpenters and provides people with a range of core and underpinning skills and knowledge relevant to work in this field.
Qualification Structure and Rules	<p>To obtain this qualification all 19 core competency units and 11 elective competency units must be achieved.</p> <p>Core competency units cannot be substituted. However, a maximum of two relevant electives from AQF III level competency units may be substituted from other qualifications within the General Construction Training Package or from other endorsed Training Packages.</p>
Notes	<p>This is a sample training program only and is appropriate for a person working as a Carpenter in the Construction Industry.</p> <p>The electives listed comply with the General Construction Training Package (BCG03) structuring rules.
