<b>Qualification</b>	Certificate III in Painting and Decorating
<b>Qualification code</b>	BCG30603
<b>Description</b>	Painters and Decorators apply paint, varnish, wallpaper and other finishes to protect, maintain and decorate interior and exterior surfaces of domestic, commercial and industrial buildings and other structures.
<b>Qualification Structure and Rules</b>	<p>To obtain this qualification all 20 core competency units and four elective competency units from the following table must be achieved.</p> <p>Core competency units cannot be substituted. However, a maximum of one elective may be substituted by selecting a relevant competency unit from another qualification within the General Construction Training Package or from another endorsed Training Package.</p>
